1. HOMEPAGE





3. STATE MEMBERS

In the **Institutes** subsection you will find a list of all the Institutes operating in that country. In **National Societies** you can find the relevant National Societies for the country.

In **National Journals** there are the National Journals published in that country. Finally, under **International Collaborations**, there is an illustrative list of research projects in the forensic field in which the country has participated and/or participates in.

In addition, for each country you will be able to access a **Virtual Library**, in which, by clicking on the cover of each journal, you will be redirected to a PubMed page which lists all the publications by that country in the course of the year in that journal [Figure 11].

4. SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION

Here you will find the link to the **International Journal of Legal Medicine**, which is the official publication of the IALM [Figure 12 - a].

Secondly, there is the link to **International Journals of Legal Medicine** [Figure 12 - b].

The third link is to **Journals of interest to the Forensic Sciences indexed in PubMed** [Figure 12 - c]. In this subsection, it is possible to indicate to the staff of the Website other journals that may be relevant. In order to do this, you need to access and fill out the **electronic form** [Figure 13].

To access the new subsection **Guidelines** click on the relevant link [Figure 12 - d]. Here you will find a list of Legal Medicine subjects, including *Clinical Forensic Medicine*, *Forensic Genetics*, *Forensic Pathology*, *Forensic Toxicology*, *Medical Malpractice and miscellaneous* [Figure 14]. For each subject a selection of Guidelines is already available and others will be available in the future. In this subsection, it is possible to indicate to the staff of the Website other guidelines that may be relevant. In order to do this, you need to fill out the **electronic form** [Figure 15].

Fourthly, there is a link to **International Societies** relating to the Forensic Sciences [Figure 12 - e].

In the link for **International Collaborations** you will be able to find some proposals and requests for collaboration on International Research Projects [Figure 12 - f].

In the **Forensic Links** subsection you can find links to websites of interest to Forensic Medicine[Figure 12 - g].






