Greetings from the IALM President


Dear Colleagues and Friends,

The 2016 Symposium of the International Academy of Legal ■ Medicine (IALM) will discuss the present and future evolution of Bio-Medicolegal



genomic framework of Personalized Medicine, in terms of Innovation, Unitariness and Evidence.

The unitariness of the "Bio-Medicolegal Sciences", historically founded on the accuracy and rigor of the methods of ascertainment and criteria of evaluation, should re-establish itself on molecular evidence, in the promotion of a Personalized Justice.

Alongside the aforementioned, the perennial and everpresent issues and topics of the Bio-Medicolegal and

Forensic Sciences will be given ample space, in order to foster and encourage active discussions and fruitful insights, while at the same time offering valuable up-to-date Educational contents and opportunities.

Ethos of the Symposium

The Syntagma "Innovation - Unitariness - Evidence" will constitute the main theme of the Symposium, to be articulated in Sessions on the subjects of Forensic Pathology and Anthropology on the Dead Person, Clinical Legal and Forensic Medicine on the Living Person, from interpersonal

> violence to personal injury and damage, malpractice and personal identification, in addition to Medicolegal Laboratory issues, Forensic Entomology, Forensic Genetics, Forensic Odontology, Forensic Radiology and Forensic Toxicology.

The Historical Significance of the Symposium Logo

The plague mask, with its long beak and empty eyes, was first described in the 17th Century by its probable inventor, Charles de Lorme, (chief physician of Louis XIII), who wrote about its strange appearance thus: "The nose [is] half a foot long shaped like a beak, filled with perfume with only two holes, one on each side near the nostrils, but that can suffice to breathe and carry along with the air one breathes the impression of

one breathes the impression of the [herbs] enclosed further along in the beak". Today, the plague mask lives on in the imaginations of artists, writers and film-makers and is also associated with a character in the commedia dell'arte, called the Plague Doctor, not to mention that it is one of the most distinctive masks worn during the Venice Carnival.

Involvement of Scientific Societies and Associations

For any eventual Workshops/ Sessions to be promoted and organized by those Scientific Societies and/or Associations interested in participating in the IALM Symposium, numerous facilities are available:

- for Workshops to be organized at the San Servolo Congress Center on Tuesday, the 21st of June;
- for Sessions to be freely organized at the Venice Lido Congress Center on Wednesday and Thursday, the 22nd and 23rd of June;
- ▶ for Sessions to be organized in accordance with the format of the other LALM Parallel Sessions.



The *Final Session* will gather together the ideas and points of interest which emerge in the course of the Symposium, and will trace a vision of *Transdisciplinary Innovation* and *Future Evidence* in the framework of *Personalized Justice*.

In addition to the Sessions dedicated to the main theme of the Symposium, the availability of facilities for the organization of Workshops at the San Servolo Congress Center (numerous conference rooms with a capacity ranging from 12 to 240 persons) and parallel joint/individual Sessions at the Venice Lido Congress Center (numerous conference rooms with a capacity ranging from 100 to >1000 persons) is vast.



A number of International Scientific Societies and Institutions, including the Association for European Cardiovascular Pathology (AECVP), the European Workplace Drug Testing Society (EWDTS), the Society of Hair Testing (SoHT), the International Criminal Court (ICC), the New Mediterranean Academy of Forensic Sciences (nMAFS), have already confirmed their participation, whilst others, such as the International Society for Criminology (ISC), the African Society of Forensic Medicine (ASFM), the American Board of Independent Medical Examiners

Independent Medical Examiners
(ABIME), the Asia Pacific Medico-Legal
Agencies (APMLA), the International
Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)
and the World Association for
Medical Law (WAML), are evaluating the
feasibility of their participation.

The schedule of the IALM Preliminary Scientific Programme will be available soon in downloadable format both on the Symposium's Official Website and the IALM Website.



Oral Communications

All Oral Communications are welcome, with no thematic restriction. It would be preferable, nevertheless, if they pertain to the following subjects.

- Forensic Anthropology on the Dead and the Living Person, with special focus on Personal Identification and Age Estimation.
- Forensic Pathology, including ballistics, histopathology, histochemistry and molecular biology, preventative pathology, thanatology and specific topics such as traffic injuries and deaths, work-related deaths and complex suicides.
- ▶ Clinical Legal and Forensic Medicine with special focus on interpersonal violence (also dealing with criminological and criminogenetic issues), Personal Injury Ascertainment in Criminal and Civil Law, Medical Malpractice, Personal Damage Evaluation under Civil/Tort Law.
- Forensic Radiology, with a special focus on post-mortem magnetic resonance imaging, post-mortem angiography, non-invasive forensic imaging in the living, micro- and nano-imaging.
- Forensic Genetics including thematic areas such as genomic identification markers, next generation sequencing, lineage markers, phenotype reconstruction, population genetics, biostatistics, DNA databases, quality standards and accreditation.
- Forensic Toxicology, including forensic analytical chemistry, methods development and validation, markers of alcohol abuse, hair analysis, post-mortem toxicology, driving under the influence of drugs and alcohol, fitness to work.
- Forensic Odontology, on the Dead and the Living Person.
- Forensic Entomology, with a special focus on time since death estimation and forensic entomo-toxicology.
- Forensic Psychopathology, with a focus on neurobiology, neuroimaging, medical malpractice in psychiatry, and sexual violence on minors.
- Criminology, including criminogenesis and crime prevention, neurobiology of criminal conducts, migration, drugs and crime, victimology, and cyber crime.
- ▶ Systems Biology applied to Bio-medicolegal Sciences, such as forensic metabolomics and proteomics.

A limited number of groundbreaking Oral Presentations, in terms of scientific and innovative value, will be selected for presentation during the Sessions to be held in the Main Auditorium of the Lido di Venezia Congress Center.


